Pricing for Machine Quilting

Preparation of and Shipping your quilt:

1. Keep layers separate - do not pin or baste
2. Quilt top must be pressed, squared up, threads clipped, secure all seams, and edges backstitched.
3. Please do not add embellishments
4. Backing: use a good quality cotton or quilting fabric. no bed sheets please. (I do not supply backing at this time)
5. Measurement of Backing and Batting must be at least 6" wider and longer than your quilt top.
6. Press backing and trim off selvages. Square up your backing
7. Mark the top of the quilt - and backing
8. Packaging and Shipping - Ship via USPS or UPS. Insure your quilt. I like USPS for the delivery confirmation it provides. Additionally, before you pack your quilt put it in a large plastic bag in the box to protect it further.

Squaring quilt top or back	\$30
Rush Service	\$30

How to measure your quilt:

A standard queen size quilt is approximately 80" x 90". $80 \times 90 = 7200$ sq in.
 $7200 \times .015 = \$108 + \text{basting } (340" \times .010 = \$34) = \$142.$ (standard all over design)
